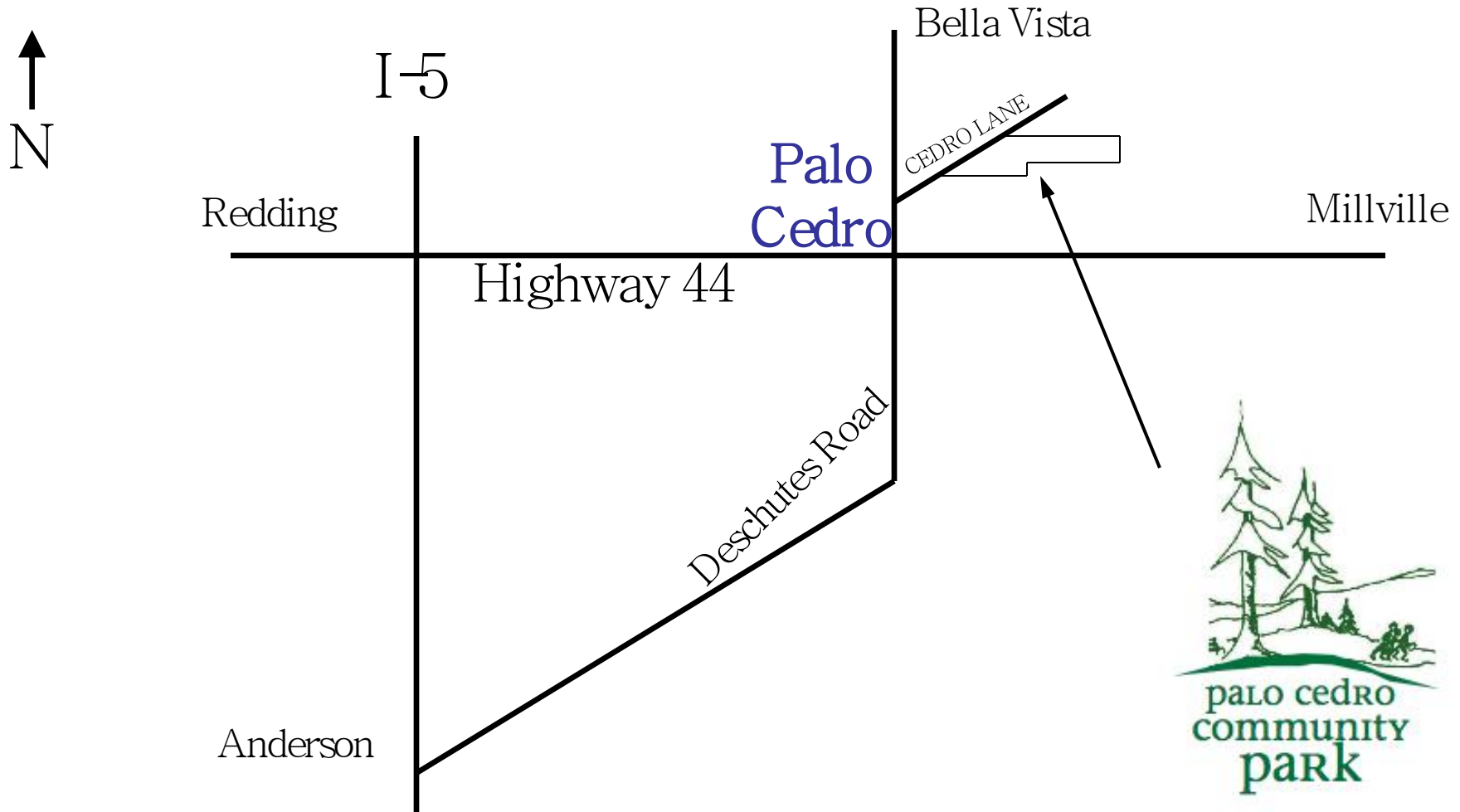

# *Palo Cedro Community Park*

## **1985 - 2000**

Palo Cedro residents initiated Park interest and raised approximately \$35,000

Palo Cedro Community Action Team (PCCAT) was formed by local citizens, led by Eileen Fox to:

- assess community's desire and expectations for a Park,
- inspire excitement,
- develop a team within the community to create a Park.

PCCAT formally established its goals and defined its purpose –



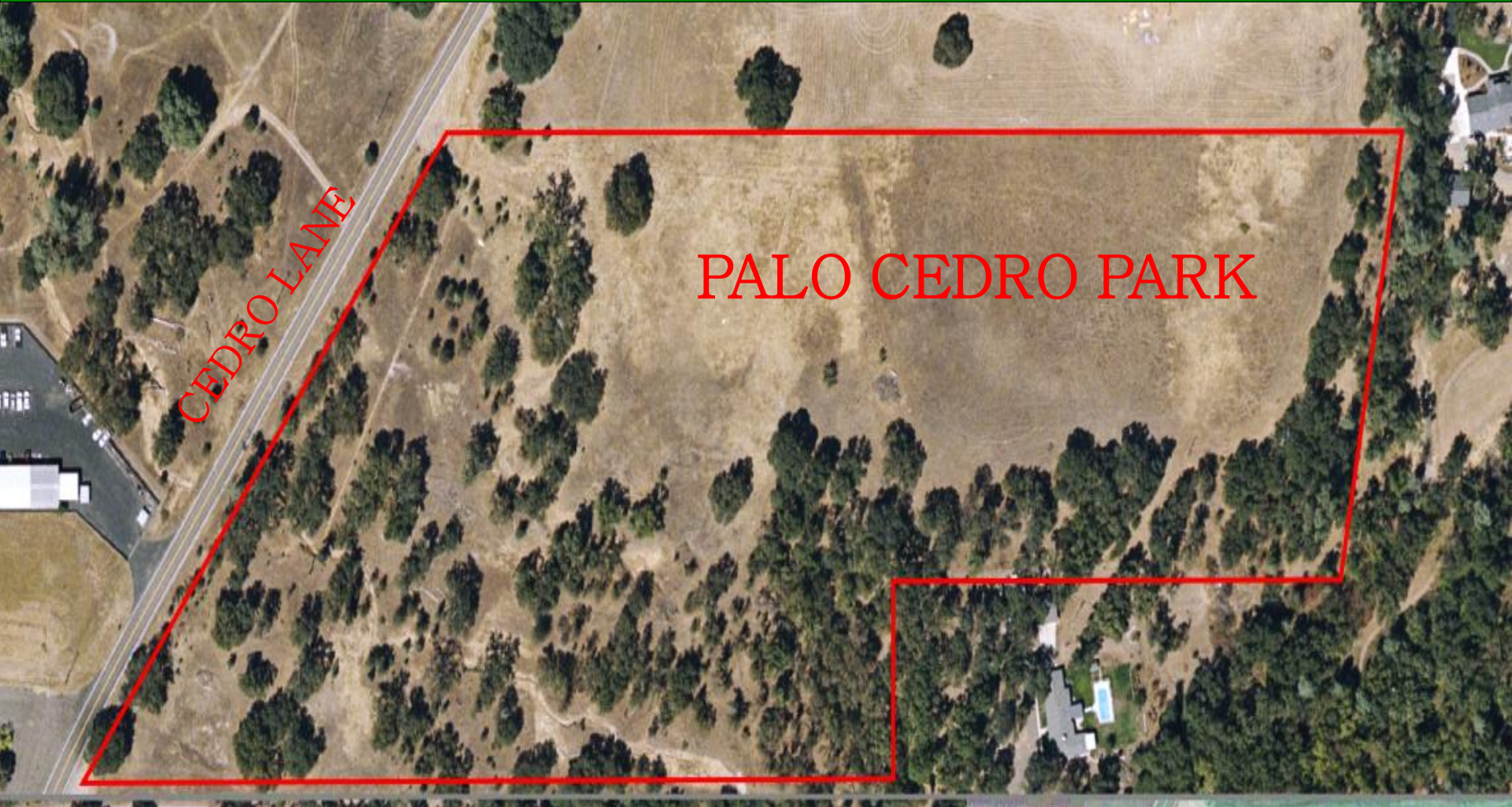

# HISTORY

## *Palo Cedro Community Park*

### 2001 - 2004

- PCCAT incorporated as a 501(c)(3) Public Benefit non-profit corporation by Bill Reilly and Associates of Palo Cedro
- Shasta County set aside \$50,000 of Proposition 12 funds for Palo Cedro Park development to match previous Park funding efforts
- PCCAT selected target properties and began negotiations for the site of the Palo Cedro Park
- PCCAT purchased 18.23 acres from Homer and Lois Park's family, longtime community supporters
- Surveyed Community for potential of the Park
- Secured services of Nichols Melburg Rossetto to develop a preliminary site plan

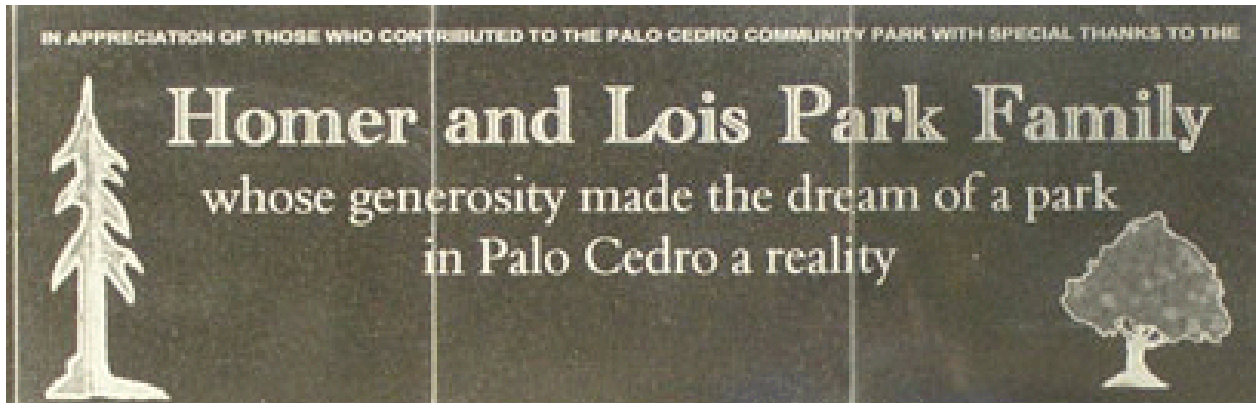

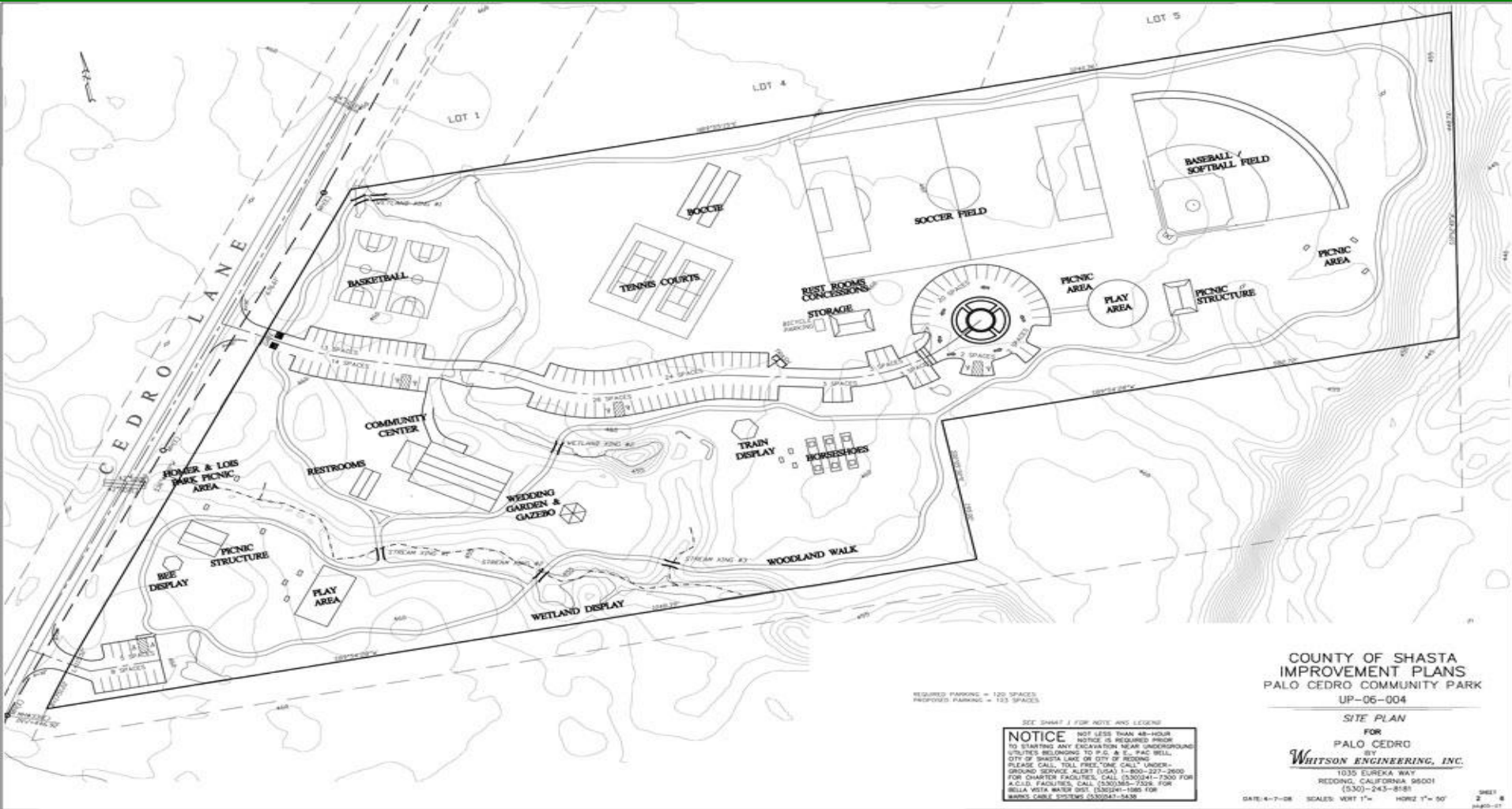

# HISTORY

## *Palo Cedro Community Park*

### 2005 – 2008

- Park site was annexed into the local Shasta County Community Service Area (CSA) #8 for water and sewer service
- Hired Karen McGrath, Park Consultant to develop Park landscape plan
- Staked proposed facilities and the entrance to begin County Use Permit application
- Completed perimeter fencing required the County Use Permit. Prepared more than 1 mile of the Park's trail system for use in the 2007 Pumpkin Festival Fun Run – Ray Toney and Associates. \$60,000
