PALO CEDRO COMMUNITY PARK SECURITY

Use permit No. 06-004

The Palo Cedro Park is private property owned by Palo Cedro Community Action Team (PCCAT), a California non profit 501(c)(3) corporation. It is managed by the Park Board of Directors. A use permit has been issued by Shasta County to the PCCAT. Several provisions of the Use Permit require submitting a security and fencing plan to the Planning Director for approval. Those relative provisions are:

27. A security plan, including perimeter fencing, lighting and security personnel, shall be submitted for review and approval by the Planning Director in conjunction with the Sheriff's office. Additional security personnel may be required during special events. *We understand potential requirement for additional security for events with more than 360 people as provided in Use permit Condition No. 33 which is not addressed herein and will be addressed prior to any special event as required.*

28. The fencing along the property line along Cedro Way shall be decorative fencing. The proposed fencing shall be shown on the plans for review and approval by the Planning Director.

29. The applicant shall provide the Sheriff's office and County Fire Department with written authorization to enter the project site at any time Sheriff's office or County Fire Department deem necessary. Appropriate signs with ordinances citations shall be posted where deemed necessary.

30. Vegetation shall be cleared and maintained to permit visibility of all areas of the park from Cedro Way and the access driveway.

31. A locking gate shall be locked across the access driveways (s) within 100 feet of Cedro Way. A sheriff's office and County Fire Department shall have access through the gate.

PARK HOURS & USE CONDITIONS

The hours the park is normally open to visitors will be posted at each front gate as established by Use Permit condition No. 8. The posting will also include general park use conditions including but not limited to no smoking in the park and no alcohol outside of the club house. Groups reserving use of the park will be giving a copy of the rules governing the use of the park and the facility they are reserving.

PARK SECURITY PLAN

The front gate postings include a telephone numbers for the public to call in the event any suspicious activities occur in the park or in the event that damage to the park or a perceived danger to the general public exists in the park. In the event of any incidents of immediate danger occupants of the park are advised to call 911 for County emergency services. Other matter may be referred to the PCCAT via the parks general phone number of 530-547-2727. All activities in the park shall have a designated person or committee who is familiar with the rule and regulations of operations in the park. This person may be a board member, a security person or company, or some person the board designates.

All groups using the park and the surrounding neighbors will be giving a copy of the park use conditions and advised to contact the posted telephone number if they observe any person or groups not in compliance with the rules of the park. Any person or group not in compliance with the park use conditions and rules will be considered to be trespassing. The sheriffs department and particularly those Deputies assigned to the Palo Cedro area will also be giving a copy of the park rules. In the event they are called they will have a basis of enforcing the trespassing.
